

GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT

AMENDMENTS TO BILL 24

ADULT GUARDIANSHIP AND TRUSTEESHIP ACT

A1E Agreed to November 5, 2008

The Bill is amended as follows:

E Section 24 is struck out and the following is substituted:

Interpretation

24(1) An application for the appointment of a guardian under section 26(1) may be made in respect of a person who has not attained the age of majority if the person will attain the age of majority within 12 months.

(2) Where an application is made in respect of a person referred to in subsection (1),

- (a) subject to the regulations, this Act and the regulations apply in respect of the application and, if a guardianship order is made, in respect of the guardianship order, as if the person were an adult;
- (b) a guardianship order may be made in respect of the person but does not take effect until the person attains the age of majority.
