

**GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT**

**AMENDMENTS TO BILL 24**

**ADULT GUARDIANSHIP AND TRUSTEESHIP ACT**

A1H Agreed to November 5, 2008

**The Bill is amended as follows:**

**H Section 43 is struck out and the following is substituted:**

**Interpretation**

**43(1)** In this Division, “personal representative” in respect of a deceased person means the executor of the person’s will or the administrator of the person’s estate.

(2) An application for the appointment of a trustee under section 46(1) may be made in respect of a person who has not attained the age of majority if the person will attain the age of majority within 12 months.

(3) Where an application is made in respect of a person referred to in subsection (2),

- (a) subject to the regulations, this Act and the regulations apply in respect of the application and, if a trusteeship order is made, in respect of the trusteeship order, as if the person were an adult;
- (b) a trusteeship order may be made in respect of the person but does not take effect until the person attains the age of majority.
