APPROPRIATION (SUPPLEMENTARY SUPPLY) ACT, 2012

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN:

Preamble

WHEREAS it appears by a Message from His Honour Donald S. Ethell, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Supplementary Supply Estimates accompanying the Message, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain charges and expenses of the Legislative Assembly and the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the fiscal year ending March 31, 2012 and for other purposes relating thereto:

MAY IT THEREFORE PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY that it be enacted and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, as follows:

Expense and capital investment

1 From the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum of \$3 100 000 towards defraying the further charges and expenses of the Legislative Assembly classed as expense and capital investment for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2012, not otherwise provided for, as shown in the Schedule.

Expense

2 From the General Revenue Fund, there may be paid and applied a sum of \$97 637 000 towards defraying the further charges and expenses of the Public Service classed as expense for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2012, not otherwise provided for, as shown in the Schedule.

Transfers

3 The sum of \$30 000 000 in the capital investment vote of the Department of Municipal Affairs is transferred to the expense vote of the Department of Municipal Affairs, as shown in the Schedule.

Accountability

4 The due application of all money expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
