LIVING FAITH BIBLE COLLEGE AMENDMENT ACT, 2015

(Assented to _____, 2015)

Preamble

WHEREAS the Living Faith Bible College, an educational ministry that has been wholly-owned and operated by the Living Faith Evangelistic Association since May 6, 1971, was incorporated by *Living Faith Bible College Act*, chapter 31, Statutes of Alberta, 2004; and

WHEREAS the petitioner is praying that the Act be amended to change the name of the College to “Clearwater College” and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends SA 2004 c31

1 The *Living Faith Bible College Act* is amended by this Act.

2 The title of the Act is struck out and the following is substituted:

CLEARWATER COLLEGE ACT

3 The preamble is amended by striking out “and” at the end of the first recital, by striking out the second recital and substituting the following:

Explanatory Notes

1 Amends chapter 31 of the Statutes of Alberta, 2004.

2 Name change.

3 The preamble presently reads:

WHEREAS Living Faith Bible College, located near the town of Caroline, Alberta, is an educational ministry that has been wholly-owned and operated by the Living Faith Evangelistic Association since May 6, 1971; and

WHEREAS the Living Faith Evangelistic Association has duly approved the change in name of the College from Living Faith Bible College to “Clearwater College”; and

WHEREAS a petition has been presented for a Bill as set forth below, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

4 Section 1(d) is amended by striking out “Living Faith Bible College” and substituting “Clearwater College”.

5 Section 2 is repealed and the following is substituted:

Corporation continued

2 The Living Faith Bible College is continued as a corporation under the name “Clearwater College” and shall consist of the members of the Board elected or appointed pursuant to the by-laws.

6 Section 3(d) is amended by striking out “historical Reformed Christian theology” and substituting “biblical Christian theology”.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented for a Bill incorporating the Living Faith Bible College as set forth below, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition;

THEREFORE HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

4 Name change.

5 Section 2 presently reads:

Incorporation

2 Paul Reich, Randy Holt, both of Red Deer, Alberta; Trevor Lund, William Dyck, both of Edmonton, Alberta; Verdon Kerr of Peers, Alberta; James Blair of Morrin, Alberta; Gordon Setterlund of Sherwood Park, Alberta; Kathryn Wall of Rocky Mountain House, Alberta; and Dennis Traverse of Cranbook, British Columbia; and such other persons as are from time to time appointed to be members of the Board are hereby incorporated under the name of “Living Faith Bible College”.

6 Section 3(d) presently reads:

3 The objects of the College are

(d) to further the intellectual, spiritual, moral, physical, social and cultural development of, as well as a community spirit among, its students, graduates, faculty and staff, in accordance with historical Reformed Christian theology, covenants, doctrines, beliefs and convictions;
