Bill 205

Pharmacy and Drug (Pharmaceutical Equipment Control) Amendment Act, 2016

A1-SA2 Agreed to May 16, 2016

Mr. Cyr to move that Amendment A1 to Bill 205, *Pharmacy and Drug (Pharmaceutical Equipment Control) Amendment Act, 2016*, be amended by striking out Part D and substituting the following:

D Section 5 is amended in the proposed section 39.1

(a) by renumbering it as section 39.1(1);

(b) in subsection (1) by striking out "18.81" and substituting "18.81(1)";

(c) in subsection (1)(b) by adding "or to imprisonment for a term of not more than 6 months or to both fine and imprisonment" after "\$125,000";

(d) in subsection (1)(c) by striking out "6 months" and substituting "1 year";

(e) by adding the following after subsection (1):

(2) A prosecution under this section may be commenced within 2 years after the commission of the alleged offence, but not afterwards.

~~(3) A member of the Executive Council shall, within 6 months of the coming into force of this section, beg leave of the Assembly to introduce a Bill to amend the *Victims of Crime Act* to provide for the funds collected from any fines imposed under this section to be deposited in the *Victims of Crime Fund* established under the *Victims of Crime Act*.~~
