

GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT**AMENDMENTS TO BILL 21****AN ACT TO PROTECT PATIENTS**

A7 Agreed to November 8, 2018

The Bill is amended as follows:

A Section 7(b) is amended

(a) by striking out the proposed section 45(3) and substituting the following:

(3) A person whose practice permit and registration are cancelled as a result of a decision of unprofessional conduct based in whole or in part on sexual abuse may not apply for the practice permit to be reissued and the registration reinstated.

(3.1) A person whose practice permit and registration are cancelled as a result of a decision of unprofessional conduct based in whole or in part on sexual misconduct may not apply for the practice permit to be reissued and the registration to be reinstated until at least 5 years have elapsed from the date that the decision of unprofessional conduct was made by the hearing tribunal.

(b) in the proposed section 45(4) by striking out “until at least 5 years have elapsed from the date that the decision of unprofessional conduct was made by the governing body of a similar profession in that other jurisdiction”;

(c) in the proposed section 45(5) by striking out “subsection (3) or (4)” and substituting “subsection (3.1)”.

B Section 26 is amended in the proposed section 135.92(2)(g) by striking out “sexual abuse or”.
