An Act to Validate and Confirm By-laws numbered 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 31 and 32 of the Town of Redcliff.

(Assented to

, 1913).

WHEREAS the municipal council of the Town of Redcliff, purporting to act under and by virtue of the authority conferred upon it by The Town Act did pass By-laws Numbered 8 and 31 of the said town authorizing the issue of debentures of the said town for the sums of \$54,600.00 and \$21,000.00 respectively, for the purposes set forth in said by-laws;

And whereas the said municipal council of the Town of Redcliff did pass By-law Number 4 of the said town authorizing the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer to sign a certain agreement between the municipal corporation of the Town of Redcliff and the Alma Steel Works of Sheffield, England;

And whereas the said municipal council of the Town of Redcliff did pass By-law Number 6 of the said town authorizing the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer to sign a certain agreement between the municipal corporation of the said town and Bernard Brittain, of Sheffield, England, Steel Manufacturer, and Edmunson Betts Plewes of the City of Winnipeg, in the Province of Manitoba, Manufacturer's Agent;

And whereas the said municipal council of the Town of Redcliff did pass By-law Number 7 of the said town authorizing the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer to sign a certain agreement between the municipal corporation of the Town of Redcliff and S. M. Knechtel of the City of Medicine Hat, in the Province of Alberta, Manufacturer;

And whereas the said municipal council of the Town of Redcliff did pass By-law Number 9 of the said town authorizing the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer to sign a certain agreement between the municipal corporation of the said town and the Hammond Stooker Company, Limited, of Redcliff, aforesaid;

And whereas the said municipal council of the Town of Redcliff did pass By-law Number 32 of the said town authorizing the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer to sign a certain agreement between the municipal corporation of the said town and Frederick C. Young of the City of Buffalo, in the State of New York, one of the United States of America, as trustee for the Redcliff Glove Manufacturing Company, Limited, and Alberta Shoe Manufacturing Company, Limited;

And whereas the said by-laws before being passed received the assent of two-thirds of the burgesses of the said town voting thereon;

And whereas certain doubts have arisen as to the validity of the said By-laws numbered 8 and 31, and of the debentures to be issued thereunder by the said Town of Redcliff; And whereas certain doubts have arisen as to the validity of said By-laws numbered 4, 6, 7, 9 and 32;

And whereas the Town of Redcliff has prayed by its petition that the said by-laws may be validated;

And whereas it is deemed expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. By-laws numbered 8 and 31 of the Town of Redeliff are hereby confirmed and declared legal, valid and binding upon the said Town of Redeliff, notwithstanding any want of jurisdiction, power of authority on the part of the municipal corporation of the said Town of Redeliff to pass the said by-laws, and notwithstanding any defect or error in substance or in form of any of said by-laws, and each and all of the debentures issued or to be issued under each of the said by-laws are hereby declared valid, legal and binding upon the said Town of Redeliff and the ratepayers thereof.

2. By-laws numbered 4, 6, 7, 9 and 32 of the Town of Redcliff are hereby confirmed and declared legal, valid and binding, notwithstanding any want of jurisdiction, power or authority on the part of the municipal corporation of the said Town of Redcliff to pass the said by-laws, and notwithstanding any defect or error in substance or in form of of any of said by-laws.
