An Act to Amend the Medical Profession Act.

(Assented to, 1913).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Medical Profession Act*, being chapter 28 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1906, as amended by chapter 27 of the Statutes of Alberta of 1911 and 1912, is hereby further amended as follows: section 35 of the said Act as amended by said chapter 27 is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following proviso:

“Provided, however, that any person, who being a graduate of a medical college in Canada, approved by the Senate of the University, is the holder of a license to practise the profession of physician and surgeon in the province in which such college is situated or is legally entitled to obtain such license in such province without any further examination, shall, upon application and upon complying with the other provisions of this Act, but without being required to pass any examination, be granted a certificate by the registrar of the University that he or she is duly qualified to practise medicine, surgery and midwifery as hereinbefore provided.”
