An Act to Authorize Paul Karrer to Practise Dentistry.

(Assented to _____, 1913.)

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that Paul Karrer, a resident of Edmonton, Alberta, and a fully qualified Dental Surgeon of Russia, Switzerland and the United States of America, may be granted a license to practise dentistry in the Province of Alberta;

And whereas, the said Paul Karrer does not write the English language and therefore cannot comply with the requirements of section 23 of *The Dental Association Act*;

And whereas, it has been made to appear that it will be a convenience to a great many residents in the Province of Alberta who speak languages known to the said Paul Karrer if he be permitted to practise dentistry in said province;

And whereas, it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Paul Karrer, of the City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, student, is hereby licensed and ordered to be registered as a duly qualified student or assistant dental practitioner and entitled to practise dentistry as an assistant to a duly qualified and registered dental practitioner of the Province of Alberta, under the provisions of chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1906, and any amendments thereto, being *An Act respecting the Dental Association of Alberta*.

2. After serving one year as such student or assistant of such duly qualified and registered dental practitioner the said Paul Karrer shall become licensed and it is hereby ordered that he shall then be registered as a person entitled to practise dentistry in the Province of Alberta under the provisions of the said Act.

3. Upon furnishing a certificate from such duly qualified and registered dental practitioner that he has so served as an assistant for a period of one year, and upon tendering payment of the registration fee required under section 16 of the said Act, a certificate of registration shall be issued by the said association to the said Paul Karrer, and his name shall be entered upon the register of the Dental Association and he shall thereafter be entitled to practise the profession of dentistry in the Province of Alberta, subject to the same fees, rules and laws as other practitioners who have become licensed under the said Act.
