An Act to authorize James Robert Cruikshank to Assist
in the Practice of Dentistry in the Province of
Alberta.

(Assented to _____, 1913.)

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by James Robert Cruikshank of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, praying to be allowed to assist in the practice of dentistry in the Province of Alberta;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petitioner;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That notwithstanding anything in *The Dental Association Act*, being chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1906, James Robert Cruikshank of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, shall be entitled in the said province, and upon the request and under the supervision of any licentiate or member of the Alberta Dental Association, to take impressions of the mouth, or any portion of the mouth, of any person and fit dental appliances therein, and to otherwise assist in dentistry, upon his being employed so to do either generally or in any particular case by any such licentiate, or member of the said association, but nothing herein contained shall entitle the said James Robert Cruikshank to practise within the province the profession of dentistry, either publicly or privately, for hire, gain or hope of reward, or to assume any title, addition or description implying or calculated to lead people to infer or believe him to be a duly qualified licentiate of dentistry otherwise than provided for in this Act.
