No. 43 of 1913 (Second Session).

An Act to Authorize the City of Calgary to Transfer or Convey a portion of Mewata Park to the Government of the Dominion of Canada as a Site for an Armoury.

(Assented to , 1913.)

WHEREAS a petition has been received from the City of Calgary praying for an Act authorizing the said city to transfer or convey a portion of Mewata Park in the said city to the Government of the Dominion of Canada as a site for an armoury to be erected thereon, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The council of the City of Calgary is hereby authorized and empowered to pass a by-law authorizing and directing the mayor and clerk of the said city to sign and execute on behalf of the City of Calgary, a transfer or quit claim deed of all the estate or interest of the said city in that portion of Mewata Park within the said city, to be described in the said by-law, to the Government of the Dominion of Canada as a site for an armoury to be erected thereon by the said Government of the Dominion of Canada:

Provided, that the said by-law shall before receiving its final reading by the said council, be ratified or approved of by a majority of the persons duly qualified to vote at an election for mayor and aldermen of the City of Calgary at a vote to be taken thereon on such day and hour as stated in the said by-law.
