Original Charter passed February 16th, 1912.
Section 13 provided that road should be
started within two years and completed within
five years.

Section 1 of Chapter 41 of Statutes of 1913
(Second Session) provided that road shall be
started within one year and finished within
five years from October 25th, 1913.

This Bill now seeks further extension of one
year and five years from the passing of this
Bill.

BILL

No. 4 of 1914.

An Act to amend Chapter 31 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1911-1912, being An Act to Incorporate the Athabasca Valley Railway Company.

(Assented to _____, 1914.)

WHEREAS the Athabasca Valley Railway Company has presented a petition praying for the amendment of the Act incorporating the said company, being chapter 31 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1911-1912, as hereinafter set out;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The section substituted for section 13 of the said Act by section 1 of chapter 41 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1913 (Second Session), is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:

“The construction of the line hereby authorized shall be commenced within one year and shall be completed within five years from the coming into force of this amending Act and section 68 of *The Railway Act* shall not apply to the said company.”
