WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the Central Canada Railway Company praying for an amendment to its Act of incorporation, being chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1913 (First Session), and to authorize the company to construct and operate the line of railway hereinafter set forth;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the

said petition;
Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Section 6 of the Act incorporating the Central Canada Railway Company, being chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta 1913 (First Session), is hereby amended by adding

thereto the following subsection:

"(2) The company may also lay out, construct and operate a line of railway from a point in the vicinity of Sucker Creek in Alberta on the Edmonton, Dunvegan and British Columbia Railway to a point Grouard

in Alberta.
"(3) The construction of the said line of railway hereby authorized shall be commenced within one year and completed within years from the date of the coming into force of this amending Act."
