WHEREAS a petition has been presented by the City of Edmonton, praying for the amendment of *The* Edmonton Charter;

And whereas it is reasonable that the prayer of the

said petition should be granted;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Edmonton Charter is hereby amended as follows:

1. By repealing subsection (c) of section 86 and by substituting therefor the following:

"(c) The names of all persons, both male and female, being British subjects as aforesaid, of the full age of twenty-one years, who have for or during one month prior to the first day of June in the year for which the voters' list is being prepared, resided or made their fixed and permanent domicile in the City of Edmonton."

2. All grants of money heretofore made or hereafter to be made by the council for any loyal and patriotic purpose in connection with or by reason of the war now being waged by His Majesty in Europe, are hereby confirmed and declared valid and within the powers of the council.
