An Act to amend The Mines Act, 1913.

(Assented to _____, 1915.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Mines Act, 1913*, is amended by adding thereto, immediately after section 34 thereof, the following subsection:

“3. The entire amount of the wages earned by or payable to any person or persons employed in or about a mine shall be paid at the mine in cash or by cheque, cashable at par at an office of the company at the mine, or at the office of an incorporated bank at the nearest convenient banking point to the mine, and the term “cash” for the purposes of this section shall mean and include current coin or other lawful money of Canada and notes, bills, drafts or orders for the payment of money to the bearer on demand, drawn upon an incorporated bank or any branch thereof, and any contract made between any person or persons employed in or about a mine and his employer wherein any provision shall be made directly or indirectly contrary to this section respecting the place where or the manner in which or the person or persons with whom the whole or any part of the wages due, or to become due to any person or persons employed in or about a mine, shall be paid out, used or expended, shall be and is hereby declared illegal, null and void.”
