An Act to amend The Lethbridge City Charter.

(Assented to _____, 1916.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Title No. XXXVI, section 5, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

“Or in the alternative the council may by by-law impose a penalty for nonpayment of taxes or any part thereof on or before the day or days named in the said by-law, such penalty not to exceed twelve per cent. (12%) per annum, and the said penalty may be imposed as a monthly penalty so long as it does not exceed one per cent. (1%) per month, and such penalty shall be added to the unpaid taxes or assessment or rates or instalment or collected by the city treasurer or by distraint or otherwise as if it had been originally imposed by by-law.”

2. Title XXIV, section 2, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

“The council may by by-law raise money by way of treasury notes upon any unpaid taxes due to the said city except current taxes, and may issue such treasury notes to secure the said loan, such loan to be payable within a period not to exceed five (5) years, and the said notes shall be a good lien upon all unpaid taxes due at the time of the passing of the said by-law.”
