An Act to authorize Oscar Daiton Weeks to Practise
Medicine and Surgery.

(Assented to _____, 1916.)

WHEREAS a petition has been presented by Oscar Daiton Weeks, of Cardston, in the Province of Alberta, praying to be allowed to practise medicine, surgery and midwifery in the said province;

And whereas it appears by the said petition that the said Oscar Daiton Weeks was graduated in medicine from The Gate City Medical College, in the State of Texas, one of the United States of America, and has been resident in Alberta for eight years;

And whereas the said Oscar Daiton Weeks is desirous of entering the Army Medical Corps for service at the Front in the European War and by reason of the exigencies of the service cannot at present have the opportunity of taking the examinations required by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the province;

And whereas the said Oscar Daiton Weeks has undertaken to submit himself for examination when opportunity offers and before entering upon private practise of his said profession in Alberta;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of said petition on the understanding hereinbefore set forth;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. It shall and may be lawful for the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta to enter and it shall enter upon the Alberta Medical Register the name of the said Oscar Daiton Weeks and issue to the said Oscar Daiton Weeks the necessary license to practise medicine, surgery and midwifery on payment of the registration fee provided for by section 38 of *The Medical Profession Act*, without his complying with the other requirements and provisions of the law and the rules and regulations of the said college in that behalf, any law, custom or usage to the contrary notwithstanding:

Provided that before entering upon private practice in the said Province of Alberta the said Oscar Daiton Weeks shall submit to such examination as to his qualifications as may be required of him by the said college.
