

# BILL

No. 18 of 1917.

An Act to amend An Act respecting Commissioners to Administer Oaths.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1917.)

**HIS MAJESTY**, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*An Act respecting Commissioners to Administer Oaths*, being chapter 11 of the Statutes of 1913 (Second Session), is amended as follows:

1. Section 5: By striking out from subsection 2 thereof the words "shall be styled "commissioners for taking affidavits in and for the Supreme Court of the Province of Alberta," (or such other court as is hereinbefore referred to and."

2. By adding thereto after section 5*b* the following section:

"5*c*. Any person acting under the provision of section 1, or of section 5*b*, subsection 1, hereof, or under appointment in accordance with the provision of section 2 hereof, shall be styled 'A commissioner for oaths'; and any person acting under the provisions of section 5*a* or of section 5*b*, subsection (2) or under appointment in accordance with the provision of section 5, hereof, shall be styled 'A commissioner for oaths without Alberta'."
