An Act to amend The Wolf Bounty Act.

(Assented to _____, 1917.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Wolf Bounty Act, being chapter 13 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1909, is amended as follows:

1. By repealing section 3 and substituting therefor the following:

“3. There shall be paid out of the general revenue of the province, on the presentation of a warrant or warrants in form approved of by the Minister, and issued by a duly appointed inspector, a bounty on adult timber-wolves of \$10.00 per head; a bounty on adult female prairie-wolves of \$2.00 per head; a bounty on pups of the timber-wolf of \$1.00 per head.”
