ANIMAL PROTECTION (PREVENTION OF ANIMAL NEGLECT) AMENDMENT ACT, 2023

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Alberta, enacts as follows:

Amends RSA 2000 cA-41

1 The Animal Protection Act is amended by this Act.

2 Section 12(1) is repealed and the following is substituted:

Offence

12(1) Except as provided for in subsection (1.1), a person who contravenes this Act or the regulations is guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of not more than \$20 000.

(1.1) A person who contravenes section 2, if the contravention is causing or permitting an animal to be or continue to be in distress as a result of abuse or undue hardship, privation or neglect, is guilty of an offence and liable to the following:

- (a) for a first offence, a fine of not more than \$25 000;
- (b) for a second offence, a fine of not more than \$35 000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months, or both;
- (c) for a third or subsequent offence, a fine of not more than \$50 000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months, or both.

Explanatory Notes

- **1** Amends chapter A-41 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000.
- **2** Section 12(1) presently reads:

12(1) A person who contravenes this Act or the regulations is guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of not more than $$20\ 000$.
