An Act to increase the Powers of the Village of Peace River.

(Assented to _____, 1918.)

WHEREAS the Village of Peace River is desirous of making arrangements for the supplying of natural gas to the said village and the inhabitants thereof;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The council of the Village of Peace River, notwithstanding anything contained in *The Village Act*, may pass a by-law authorizing the reeve and secretary-treasurer to sign a contract with any person for the supplying of natural gas for the use of the said village and the inhabitants thereof, for any period not exceeding fifteen years.

2. The procedure for the passing of by-laws referred to in Section 172 of *The Village Act* shall apply to the passing of any by-law authorized by this Act.
