An Act to increase the Powers of the Village of Peace River.

(Assented to , 1918.)

WHEREAS the Village of Peace River is desirous of making arrangements for the supplying of natural gas to the said village and the inhabitants thereof;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The council of the Village of Peace River, notwith-standing anything contained in *The Village Act*, may pass a by-law authorizing the reeve and secretary-treasurer to sign a contract with any person for the supplying of natural gas for the use of the said village and the inhabitants thereof, for any period not exceeding fifteen years.
- 2. The procedure for the passing of by-laws referred to in Section 172 of *The Village Act* shall apply to the passing of any by-law authorized by this Act.
