The Provincial Arms Act.

(Assented to _____, 1918.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Provincial Arms Act.*"

2. Any person who, without the authority of the Lieutenant Governor in Council or of the head of a Government Department, assumes or uses in connection with any trade, business, calling or profession the crest, arms, blazon or other heraldic emblem belonging to or assumed by the province, or any heraldic emblem so nearly resembling the same as to be calculated to deceive, shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars.
