An Act to amend The Timber Areas Tax Act.

(Assented to , 1918.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Timber Areas Tax Act, being chapter 15 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1914, is amended as follows:

1. By repealing section 5 thereof and substituting therefor the following:

“5. If any such proprietor fails to comply with the provisions of section 3 hereof the Minister may obtain the necessary information from the proper department of the Government of Canada, or otherwise, and fix and determine according to the information so obtained, the amount of taxes payable under this Act by such proprietor.

“(2) Any such proprietor failing to comply with any of the provisions of sections 3 or 4 hereof, shall, upon summary conviction before a justice of the peace, be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$50.00 and costs, and in default of payment thereof, to imprisonment for any term not exceeding six months.”

2. By striking out from section 8 thereof the words “and the double tax or penalty” where they appear in the ninth line of the said section and the words “and the double tax and penalty hereinbefore prescribed” where they appear in the thirteenth and fourteenth lines of the said section.

3. By striking out the word “penalties” wherever it appears in section 11 thereof.

4. By striking out the words “or penalties” where they appear in the second line of section 12 thereof.
