

REPRINTED BILL.

BILL

No. 50 of 1918.

An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to _____, 1918.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. *The Legislative Assembly Act* (as heretofore amended) is amended as follows:

1. Section 53: By striking out in subsection (2) thereof the words "during each Session of the Third Legislative Assembly" where they occur therein, and there inserting the words "during each Session of the Fourth Legislative Assembly"; and by adding as subsection (3) thereof the following:

"(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, every Member of the Legislative Assembly serving on any commission or committee appointed either by the Legislative Assembly or by the Lieutenant Governor in Council may accept such sum of money for travelling expenses and subsistence in connection therewith as the Lieutenant Governor in Council may deem proper, and in cases where no fixed amount to cover such purposes has been provided, upon the furnishing of vouchers or such other evidence as may be considered sufficient, and the receipt of any such money shall not render any Member ineligible."

2. Section 56: By adding as subsection (2) thereof the following:

"(2) Each Member elected under the provisions of *The Alberta Military Representation Act* shall be entitled to the money actually paid by him for transportation and for sleeping accommodation on steamer and train, and to an additional allowance of \$6.00 per day during the time actually spent in making the journey from the place where he was at the time of his election on military service, to Edmonton, and to like sums for his return journey; but he shall only be entitled to the latter sums upon making a solemn declaration in the manner provided by section 57 of this Act, to the effect that he intends to make and is on the point of making such return journey. Expenses allowed under this subsection shall be in lieu of all other travelling expenses allowed in this Act."
