No. 54 of 1918.

An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service of the Fiscal Years ending respectively the Thirty-first day of December, 1917, and the Thirty-first day of December, 1918, and from the First day of January, 1919, up to the date of final passage of the Estimates for the Fiscal Year ending the Thirty-first day of December, 1919.

Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour Robert George Brett, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta not otherwise provided for during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, and the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and for other purposes relating thereto: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Appropriation Act, 1918.*"

2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole two hundred and fifty-eight thousand nine hundred and seventy-six dollars and ninety-five cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventeen not otherwise provided for and set forth in schedule A to this Act.

3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole ten million five hundred and fifty-nine thousand nine hundred and twenty-six dollars and sixty-six cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighteen not otherwise provided for and set forth in schedule B to this Act.

4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole two million seven hundred and eighty thousand two hundred and fifty dollars and no cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first

day of January, 1919, up to the date of final passage of the Estimates for the fiscal year ending the thirty-first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nineteen not otherwise provided for and set forth in schedule C to this Act.

5. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
