An Act to amend the Alberta Pharmaceutical Association Act.

(Assented to 1919.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

The Alberta Pharmaceutical Association Act, being chapter 38 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1910 (2nd Session), is amended as follows:

1. Section 21, clause (c) By adding thereto the following words: "or have entered into a definite engagement or employment in a hospital having at least one hundred beds, where there is a permanent dispenser employed; provided that in any hospital having between one hundred and fifty and two hundred beds, two certified apprentices may be employed, and in any hospital having two hundred beds or more, three certified apprentices may be employed."
