An Act to amend The Registered Nurses Act.

(Assented to _____, 1919.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Registered Nurses Act, being chapter 35 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1916, is amended as follows:

1. By striking out all that part of section 4 thereof after the word "examination" in the fifth line of the said section down to and including the word "Association" in the tenth line thereof, and substituting therefor the following: "as shall be prescribed by the Senate of the University of Alberta, and the said examination shall be conducted by a Board of Examiners appointed by the said Senate."

2. By adding after the first proviso to the said section 4 the following:

"Provided further that where by or under any Act or law of any other province of Canada, or of any of the United States of America constituting an association of registered nurses, provision is made for the registering therein without examination of the members of associations constituted in other jurisdictions, the Senate of the University may, upon being satisfied that such provision extends to nurses registered under this Act, dispense with the examination required by this section in the case of any applicant who is a member of the Association of Registered Nurses constituted by such Act or law."
