

# BILL

No. 44 of 1919.

An Act to amend The Dairymen's Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1919.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

*The Dairymen's Act*, being chapter 16 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1907, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 32: By inserting the words "neither more nor less than" after the word "weigh" in the third line thereof.

2. Section 35, clause (d): By striking out the words "if bought on a grade basis".

3. Section 39: By adding thereto the following subsection:  
"(2) Any such inspector shall have authority to weigh and to take such quantities as may be reasonably required as samples of any lot of milk or cream for the purpose of testing or grading the same."

4. Section 40: By inserting after the word "obstruction" in the third line thereof the words "to any dairy inspector".  
By inserting after the word "Act" in the fifth line thereof the words "or of any regulation passed hereunder".  
By adding to the said section the following subsection:  
"(2) No owner, operator, manager or other person in charge of any creamery, cream station or cheese factory shall, in respect of any lot of milk or cream purchased from a patron, base the purchase price upon a weight, grade or classification other than the correct weight, grade or classification."

5. Section 42a: By inserting after the word "to" in the second line thereof the words "graders and".

By inserting after the word "such" at the end of the third line the words "fees and".

6. Section 43: By striking out the words "the fee for such license shall be five dollars" from the last two lines thereof.

7. Section 45: By inserting after the word "to" in the last line of the third paragraph thereof the words "suspend or".

8. Section 46: By inserting after the word "paid" in the seventh line thereof the words "at the same time".

By inserting after the word "of" in the eleventh line thereof the words "handling and".

By adding thereto the following subsection:

"(2) The amount of any allowance made under this section for handling and transportation shall be indicated in every statement delivered under section 35 or section 36 hereof, and the Minister may require returns and particulars to be forwarded to him showing the method of computing any such allowance."
