An Act to amend The Educational Tax Act.

(Assented to , 1919.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Educational Tax Act, being chapter 18 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1907, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 2: By adding thereto the following:

"(2) On, from and after January 1st, 1920, all taxes levied under this Act shall be levied at the rate of one mill in the dollar of the assessed value of all assessable land, and the incidence, method of assessment, collection and enforcement of the taxes so levied shall follow and be regulated by the provisions of *The Wild Lands Tax Act*, including therein all provisions as to penalties, liens, distress and forfeiture proceedings in so far as the provisions of the said Act pertain to lands outside of the boundaries of municipal districts; provided, however, that the provisions of this section as to a minimum tax and the taxation of leased lands shall still apply."

2. By striking out the words "rural municipality" where same appear in the said Act, and substituting therefor the words "municipal district."

3. Section 9 subsection 2: By striking out the words "on the first day of January of the year following that" where the same appear in the second line thereof, and substituting therefor the words "after the fifteenth day of December of the year"; and by striking out the words "first day of January" where the same appear in the seventh and eighth lines thereof, and substituting therefor the words "sixteenth day of December"; and by adding thereto the following:

"(4) Where a penalty of five per cent. is added, under the provisions of this section, it shall be five per cent. of the arrears of taxes and of the penalties, if any, already added." No. 59.
