HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Each of the Statutes in the schedule hereto shall notwithstanding anything in *The Interpretation Act* contained come into and be in force on and from the 30th day after the day on which it is assented to, and an endorsement to that effect shall be placed thereon by the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly.
