An Act to amend the Act incorporating The Canada Security Assurance Company being Chapter 57 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1913.

WHEREAS The Canada Security Assurance Company have by their petition prayed that their Act of Incorporation be amended as hereinafter set forth and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:-

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:-

- 1. Chapter 57 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1913, is hereby amended as follows:-
- 1. By adding immediately after the word "Company" in the third line of Section 14 thereof the words "Or such other place as may be appointed by By-law either within or without the Province of Alberta".
- 2. By adding immediately after Section 14 a new Section to be called 14-A, as follows: "The Meetings of the Shareholders, Directors, or Executive Committee of the Company may be held at any place other than the Head Office either within or without the Province of Alberta".
- 3. By striking out the words in brackets in the third fourth and fifth lines of Section 17 thereof, and inserting in their place the following words: "Not less than Seven nor more than Twelve, as may be provided by the By-Laws".
