An Act to amend The Venereal Diseases Prevention Act.

(Assented to _____, 1921.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3 of *The Venereal Diseases Prevention Act*, being chapter 50 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1918, is amended—

(a) By striking out of subsection 1 thereof the words “or under any regulation referred to in the next succeeding subsection”;

(b) By repealing subsection 2 thereof, and substituting therefor the following new subsection:

“(2) Whenever any person is under arrest or in custody, charged with an offence under *The Criminal Code* of Canada or with an offence under *The Children's Protection Act* of Alberta, then if a justice is credibly informed and believes that such person is infected with or has been infected with or exposed to infection from venereal disease, he shall so advise the board, whereupon the board may cause such person to be physically examined in order to ascertain whether he is infected with venereal disease.”
