## **BILL**

No. 7 of 1921.

An Act to amend the Act incorporating Alberta Ladies' College of Red Deer.

(Assented to

, 1921.)

WHEREAS the Alberta Ladies' College of Red Deer was incorporated by chapter 78 of the Statutes of 1913 (First Session), and whereas the college has petitioned for an amendment to the said Act changing the name of the college and to enable the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada to exercise jurisdiction, and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of

Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. The said college shall hereafter be known under the name of "Westminster Ladies' College," and the words "Alberta Ladies' College of Red Deer" where they occur in section 1, line 19, section 7, lines 3 and 4, and section 9, lines 1 and 4, are stricken out, and the words "Westminster Ladies' College" substituted in lieu thereof Ladies' College" substituted in lieu thereof.
- 2. The words "with headquarters at the Town of Red Deer" in the last line of paragraph 1 of the said Act are hereby stricken out.
- 3. Notwithstanding the change of name the said corporation may administer its property under the name "Westminster Ladies' College" as if the same were taken or held in that name, and under that name shall be liable to perform its obligations entered into under the name or style "Alberta Ladies' College of Red Deer."

4. Section 10 of the said Act is hereby amended by adding

to it the following proviso:
"Provided that the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Canada may exercise jurisdiction in respect of the said college, and for that purpose may appoint to the Board of Governors such number of members from time to time and upon such conditions as shall be agreed upon with or designated to the said Synod of Alberta.
