An Act to amend The Bills of Sale Ordinance.

(Assented to , 1921.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Bills of Sale Ordinance, being chapter 43 of the Consolidated Ordinances of the North-West Territories, 1898, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Section 9b: By repealing the same and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

“9b. Every mortgage or conveyance intended to operate as a mortgage of goods and chattels, which is not accompanied by an immediate delivery and an actual and continued change of possession of the things mortgaged, and every sale, assignment and transfer of goods and chattels not accompanied by an immediate delivery and followed by an actual and continued change of possession of the goods and chattels sold, shall be subject to all executions issued out of any court of record in the Province of Alberta, against the goods and chattels of the mortgagor, bargainor or assignor, which are filed with the Sheriff of the Judicial District in which such goods and chattels are situate at the time such mortgage was made, or alternatively, at the time such mortgage was registered.”
