An Act to amend an Act respecting Subdivided and Other Property.

(Assented to , 1921.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of An Act respecting Subdivided and Other Property, being chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1919, is amended—

(a) By changing the number thereof to 2;

(b) By striking out subsection (2) thereof;

(c) By adding as subsections (2), (3) and (4) thereof the following:

"(2) Any commissioner or commissioners appointed under this Act shall hold office during pleasure and shall be remunerated as directed by the Lieutenant Governor. "(3) In giving any such direction the Lieutenant Governor

"(3) In giving any such direction the Lieutenant Governor in Council may direct that such portion of the remuneration of the commissioner or commissioners as seems proper shall be paid by the Government of Alberta and the remainder thereof by the municipality concerned.

"(4) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may fix a tariff of fees for the services to be performed by a commissioner or commissioners under the provisions of this Act."

2. Section 1 is added to the said Act as follows:

"1. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,— ""Municipality' shall mean any city, town, village, municipal district, improvement district and school district."

3. Section 2 of the said Act is amended—

(a) By changing the number thereof to 3;

- (b) As to paragraph 2 thereof by striking out the comma after the word "city" in the first line thereof;
- (c) As to paragraph 3 thereof by striking out the comma after the word "city" in the first line thereof;

(d) By adding as paragraph 4 thereof: "4. Upon the application of the owner of any lands whether subdivided or not, which have been or are about to become forfeited for non-payment of taxes, any muni-cipality may by resolution expressly referring to such lands, request the commissioner or commissioners to reduce the request the commissioner or commissioners to reduce the arrears of taxes. The commissioner or commissioners may by order reduce the said arrears and shall have power to make all such orders as they or he could make with reference to subdivided lands under the provisions of the prior paragraph of this section."

4. Section 3 of the said Act is amended by changing the number thereof to 4.
