An Act to authorise Richard Vandersluys to Practise Dentistry.

(Assented to 1922)

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that Richard Vandersluys a resident of Carbon, in the Province of Alberta, and an apprenticed Dentist, may be granted a license to practise bentistry in the Province of Alberta.

AND WHEREAS the said Richard Vandersluys was apprentised to Abner C. Crysler of Niagra Falls in the Province of Ontario, and served as such apprentice for three years.

AND WHEREAS the said Richard Vandersluys has for five years been assisting Dr. D. D. Ross of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said Petitioner.

THEREFORE His Majesty, by and with the edvice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- I. Richard Vandersluys of the town of Carbon, in the Province of Alberta, is hereby licensed and ordered to be registered as a duly qualified bentist and entitled to practise dentistry and to become registered as a dental practitioner of the Province of Alberta under the provisions of Chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1906, and any amendments thereto, being an Act respecting the Dental Association of Alberta.
- 2. Upon tendering payment of the registration fee required under Section I6 of the said Act a certificate of registration shall be issued by the Dental Association of Alberta to the said Richard Vandersluys and his name shall be entered upon register of the said Dental Association and he shall thereafter be entitled to practise the profession of dentistry in the Province of Alberta, subject to the same rules and laws as other practitioners who have become licensed under the said Act.
