An Act to amend the Lethbridge City Charter.

(Assented to _____, 1923.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Lethbridge City Charter, being chapter 22 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1913, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. Title 36, section 6, by adding subsection (6b) thereto as follows:

“(6b) All taxes assessed and levied on a floor space basis or on a rental basis shall be a first lien upon any and all personal property situated upon the premises so assessed and shall have priority over other liens and incumbrances and the said personal property may be followed and distrained upon for thirty days after the same is removed from the said premises.”

2. Title 24, section 3, by adding section (3b) as follows:

“(3b) To license motor vehicles as defined under *The Motor Vehicles Act*, being chapter 6 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1911-12, and notwithstanding anything in the said Act.”

3. Title 24, section 4, by striking out the words “The council may also make by-laws for” where they appear in the first line of said section, and substituting the following: “For greater certainty, but not so as to limit the powers conferred by section 3, of this title, the council may make by-laws for all or any of the following purposes.”
