An Act to amend The Brand Act.

(Assented to _____, 1923.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Brand Act Amendment Act, 1923*".

2. Section 12 of *The Brand Act*, being chapter 66 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended—

- (a) as to subsection (3) thereof by striking out the words "notify him of such failure and that" and substituting therefor the words, "send a notice to him to the effect that";
- (b) as to subsection (4) thereof, by striking out the same;
- (c) as to subsection (5) thereof, by renumbering the same as (4).

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
