An Act to amend The Produce Merchants Act, 1922.

(Assented to _____, 1923.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Produce Merchants Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1923.*"

2. Section 2 of *The Produce Merchants Act, 1922*, being chapter 212 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended—

- (a) as to paragraph (b) thereof by adding thereto the following: "and shall include cattle, sheep, swine, poultry (live or dressed), eggs, vegetables of all kinds (except canned vegetables), fruit of all kinds (except canned fruits), butter and butter fat, milk, live stock feeds and hides";
- (b) by striking out paragraph (c) thereof, and substituting therefor the following:
“(c) ‘Produce merchant’ shall mean a person who in the way of business buys produce for re-sale, or sells produce upon commission, or receives produce for sale, either on commission or for account of a consignor.”

3. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the said Act is amended—

- (a) as to paragraph (b) thereof by striking out the words "one thousand dollars," and substituting therefor the words "five hundred dollars";
- (b) as to paragraph (c) thereof by striking out the words "ten dollars," and substituting therefor the words "five dollars."

4. Section 6 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (2) thereof by striking out the words "produce commission merchant," and substituting therefor the words "produce merchant."

5. Section 7a is added to the said Act as follows:

“**7a.** Whenever a produce merchant buys produce and does not at or before the time of delivery of the same to

him pay to his vendor the price thereof, he shall immediately enter in a book to be kept for that purpose the name of the vendor, the kind and quantity of produce sold and the price thereof, and shall give to the vendor a signed copy of the entry."

6. Section 8 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (1) thereof by adding after the words "who has consigned" where they occur therein the words "or sold."
