

# BILL

No. 32 of 1923.

An Act to amend The Succession Duties Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1923.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1923.*"

**2.** Section 5 of *The Succession Duties Act*, being chapter 28 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to paragraph (a) thereof by striking out the words "five thousand dollars," and substituting therefor the words "one thousand dollars."

**3.** Section 7 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (1) thereof by striking out the table of percentages contained therein, and substituting therefor the following:
