An Act respecting Bird Sanctuaries.

(Assented to , 1923.)

H^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Bird Sanctuary Act."

2. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture, constitute any land a bird sanctuary.

3. No bird sanctuary shall be constituted upon private land without the request or consent of the registered owner thereof.

4. In constituting such bird sanctuaries, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may lay down such rules and regulations as to the creation, disorganization and conduct of any such sanctuary, and may fix penalties for the breach of any such rules or regulations, and impose such fees with respect to the creation of any such bird sanctuary, as may seem necessary.
