An Act to enter George Munro Ross upon the Alberta
Medical Register without examination.

(Assented to _____, 1924.)

WHEREAS George Munro Ross, of the Village of Rumsey in the Province of Alberta, Physician and Surgeon, has by his petition prayed that it be enacted that his name be entered upon the Alberta Medical Register without being required to pass any test examination, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in *The Medical Profession Act* of the Province of Alberta, the said George Munro Ross shall be entered as a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta without examination and without fee, and the registrar of the council of the said college shall so enter the name of the said George Munro Ross in the Alberta Medical Register.

2. This Act shall come into force on the day it is assented to.
