An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to _____, 1924).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

The Legislative Assembly Act, being chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as follows:

1. By striking out the words “electoral districts” or “electoral district” wherever the same appear together in the said Act, and substituting respectively therefor the words “electoral divisions” or “electoral division.”

2. Section 2: By striking out the word “sixty-one,” and substituting therefor the word “sixty.”

3. By striking out of schedule 1 to the said Act—

(a) the electoral division of Clearwater;

(b) the described boundaries of the electoral division of Pembina, Lac Ste. Anne, Edson, and Peace River, and substituting therefor respectively the following:

“PEMBINA.—Commencing at the north-east corner of township 70, range 25, west of the 4th Meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 70 to the north-east corner of township 70, range 8, west of the 5th meridian; thence south along the east boundary of the said range 8 to its point of intersection with the centre line of the Athabasca River; thence down stream following the centre line of the Athabasca River to its point of intersection with the east boundary of township 61, range 7, west of the 5th meridian; thence south along the east boundary of said range 7 to the north-east corner of township 59, range 7, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 59 to the north-east corner of township 59, range 6, west of the 5th meridian; thence south along the east boundary of said range 6 to the north-east corner of township 56, range 6, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 56 to the north-east corner of township 56, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence south along the east boundary of the said range 4 to the north-east corner of township 55, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 55, to the north-east corner of township 55, range 1, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 1 to the north-east corner of township 57, range 1, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 57 to the north-east corner of township 57,

range 26, west of the 4th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 26 to the north-east corner of township 58, range 26, west of the 4th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 58 to its intersection with the east boundary of township 59, range 25, west of the 4th meridian, produced south; thence north along the east boundary of said range 25 to the point of commencement.

"LAC STE. ANNE.—Commencing at the north-east corner of township 59, range 6, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 59 to the north-east corner of township 59, range 7, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 7 to its point of intersection with the centre line of the Athabasca River; thence up stream following the centre line of the Athabasca River to its point of intersection with the east boundary of township 60, range 8, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 8 to the north-east corner of township 70, range 8, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 70 to the north-east corner of township 70, range 14, west of the 5th meridian; thence south along the east boundary of said range 14 to the north-east corner of township 57, range 14, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 57 to the north-east corner of township 57, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence south along the east boundary of said range 12 to the north-east corner of township 52, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 52 to the north-east corner of township 52, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 4 to the north-east corner of township 53, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 53 to the north-east corner of township 53, range 3, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 3 to the north-east corner of section 13, township 54, range 3, west of the 5th meridian; thence easterly along the north boundary of sections 18 to 13 inclusive of township 54 to the north-east corner of section 13, township 54, range 1, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 1 to the north-east corner of township 55, range 1, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 55 to the north-east corner of township 55, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 4 to the north-east corner of township 56, range 4, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 56 to the north-east corner of township 56, range 6, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 6, to the point of commencement.

"EDSON.—Commencing at the north-east corner of township 57, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 57 to the north-east corner of township 57, range 14, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 14 to the north-east corner of township 67, range 14, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 67 to its point of intersection with the west boundary of the Province of Alberta; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of the Province of Alberta to its intersection with the north boundary of township 31, range 19, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 31 to the north-east corner of township 31, range 8, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 8 to the north-east corner of township 34, range 8, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 34 to the north-east corner of township 34, range 10, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 10 to its intersection

with the centre line of the North Saskatchewan River; thence down stream following the centre line of the North Saskatchewan River to its intersection with the east boundary of township 47, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 9 to the north-east corner of township 52, range 9, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 52 to the north-east corner of township 52, range 12, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 12 to the point of commencement.

“PEACE RIVER.—Commencing at the north-east corner of township 70, range 14, west of the 5th meridian; thence west along the north boundary of township 70 to its point of intersection with the east boundary of township 71, range 22, west of the 5th meridian, produced south; thence north along the east boundary of said range 22, to the north-east corner of township 80, range 22, west of the 5th meridian; thence east along the north boundary of township 80 to the north-east corner of township 80, range 14, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of the said range 14 to its point of intersection with the north boundary of the Province of Alberta; thence west along the north boundary of the Province of Alberta to the north-west corner thereof; thence south along the west boundary of the Province of Alberta to its point of intersection with the north boundary of township 67; thence east along the north boundary of township 67 to the north-east corner of township 67, range 14, west of the 5th meridian; thence north along the east boundary of said range 14 to the point of commencement.”

4. This Act shall come into force on the day it is assented to.
