 $\pmb{\mathsf{H}}^{\mathrm{IS}}$ MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The School Act Amendment Act, 1924."

2. Section 129 of The School Act, being chapter 51 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby struck out, and the following substituted therefor: "129.—(1) Every board other than that of a town dis-

trict shall meet within ten days after each annual meeting for the purpose of organizing and transacting such other business as may be required.

"(2) The board of a town district shall meet for such purpose within ten days after the date of the annual municipal election."

3. Section 179 of the said Act is amended-

- (a) as to subsection (3) thereof—
 - (i) by striking out the words "grades above the eighth" where they occur therein, and substi-tuting therefor the words "grades IX, X, and XI";
 - (ii) by inserting after the words "such instruction is available" where they occur in the third pro-viso thereto the words "under the written authority of an inspector of schools";
 - (iii) by striking out the fourth proviso thereto.
- (b) By inserting as subsection (4) thereof the follow-

ing: "(4) The board of any district may charge for pupils in grade XII as classified by the regulations of the Department of Education, a fee of \$4.00 per month (or fractional part thereof) per pupil in attendance at its school if the parent or lawful guardian of such pupil is not a resident of the district, which fee shall be payable monthly at the end of every month by the parent or lawful guardian of such pupil."

(c) As to subsections (4) and (5) thereof by re-numbering the same as (5) and (6).

4. Section 208 of the said Act is amended by adding subsection (4) thereto as follows: "(4) Subject to the approval of the Minister, the board

"(4) Subject to the approval of the Minister, the board of trustees may, in lieu of providing conveyance as herein mentioned, make provision for the attendance at the school of the children of the district or any of them, in any other suitable manner, and in making such provision may agree to pay to the parents or guardian a sum of money not exceeding one dollar per day per family."
