A BILL TO AMEND THE MEDICAL PROFESSION ACT.

NOTE.

The Medical Profession Act penalizes the practice of any non-drug science by persons not registered under *The Medical Profession Act*.

Chiropractors are not registered under that Act, but under *The Chiropractic Act*. The Bill removes the penalty imposed in terms upon chiropractors.

An Act to amend The Medical Profession Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE.

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Medical Profession Act Amendment Act, 1925.*"

2. Section 70 of *The Medical Profession Act*, being chapter 209 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended by inserting after the words "not registered pursuant to this Act" the words "or *The Chiropractic Act.*"

3. Section 71 of the said Act is struck out.
