A BILL TO AMEND THE VITAL STATISTICS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill, with the object of obtaining more complete information for statistical purposes, provides that school teachers are to forward to the Registrar-General, the names, dates and places of birth of children entering school for the first time.

The other sections of the Bill prescribe fees payable upon the registration of legitimated children, a larger fee being asked for where the birth occurred outside the Province.

An Act to amend The Vital Statistics Act.

H IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Vital Statistics Act Amendment Act, 1925."

2. The Vital Statistics Act, being chapter 24 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 16 thereof by adding thereto as subsection (3) the following:

"(3) At the beginning of each school term, every teacher in charge of a school shall prepare a list of the children then entering school for the first time, together with the places and dates of their birth, and shall forward the same to the Registrar-General."

3. Section 18 of the said Act is amended—

- (a) as to subsection (1) thereof: By adding the words"and shall be entitled to a fee of five dollars therefor"; and
- (b) as to subsection (2) thereof: By adding the words "and shall be entitled to a fee of five dollars therefor"; and
- (c) as to subsection (3) thereof: By adding the words "and shall be entitled to a fee of ten dollars therefor."
