A BILL TO AMEND THE FACTORIES ACT.

NOTE.

Under the Act as it stands, watchmen are not within its purview. The amendments in the Bill, sections 2 and 3, are intended to bring watchmen within the Act, and at the same time permit an inspector to lengthen the hours of work subject to proper conditions for such persons, and also to bring hotels within the operation of the Act.

An Act to amend The Factories Act.

(Assented to _____, 1925.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Factories Act Amendment Act, 1925.*"

2. *The Factories Act*, being chapter 186 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to section 4 by striking out the words "or to a watchman" where they occur in the fourth line thereof.

3. Section 16 of the said Act is amended by inserting the word "hotels" between the words "bake-shops" and "offices" where they occur in the second line thereof.

4. Section 26 of the said Act is amended as to subsection (2) thereof by adding thereto the words "or of the nature of the occupation of such person."
