An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

H IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act of 1925.

2. The Legislative Assembly Act, being chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as follows:

Section 53: By striking out said section, and substituting therefor the following:

"53. In the first session of the Legislature in the year 1925, there shall be allowed and payable to each member of the Legislative Assembly attending such session an allowance of two thousand dollars and no more.

"In each successive session of the Legislature during the fifth parliament of Alberta, there shall be allowed and payable to each member of the Legislative Assembly attending such session an allowance of one thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars.

"In each successive session after the conclusion of the present parliament there shall be allowed and payable to each member of the Legislative Assembly attending such session an allowance of seventeen hundred dollars, no more; provided that in case two sessions of the Legislature be held in any one year no allowance shall be made for the second session:

"Provided further, that unless illness, certified by a qualified medical practitioner, be the cause of absence, and except in the cases provided for in section 55 hereof, the sessional allowance of a member who does not attend sittings of the Assembly or meetings of some committee thereof on at least one-half of the total number of sitting days in any session shall be ten dollars for each day of attendance and no more."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day it is assented to.
