Under the provisions of this Act, chattel mortgages taken to secure money advanced by way of relief do not require renewal if taken in the years 1919, 1920 and 1921. The amendment makes the same provision with regard to chattel mortgages taken in 1922.

An Act to amend The Provincial Relief Act, 1922.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as “*The Provincial Relief Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1925.*”
- 2.** Section 8 of *The Provincial Relief Act, 1922*, being chapter 66 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is amended as to subsection (2) thereof by inserting before the words “shall require renewal” the words “or under this Act.”
- 3.** This Act shall come into force on the.....day of.....1925.
